From 15 December, a COVID vaccination will no longer be mandatory for staff, students, residents or visitors when visiting the Sydney campus, though still strongly encouraged.

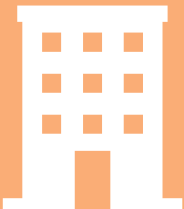
Access to the Ministry and Learning Centre (MALC)



All staff, students and visitors accessing MALC will still need to adhere to the College's COVID-safe plan by:

- Signing-in to campus through the NSW QR code as well as our Morling Who's on location program .
- Maintaining social distancing and capacity limits as required at all times.
- Ensuring that areas are left clean after use.
- Not coming to campus if you have symptoms or have been directed to isolate.

MRC, Morling Village, CCSC/Ezra & other organisations on campus



Due to their different context, we will take into consideration the COVID safe plans of each organisation, and their decisions about vaccination and access. Until notified otherwise, if you are not vaccinated, we ask that you do not visit these spaces unless approved by them. In these spaces we especially want to ensure the safety and wellbeing of the vulnerable within our community; including children who do not yet have access to vaccinations.



Gilbert Wright Library

Level 2 of the Gilbert Wright Library is open for browsing and study activities. Reservation processes will return to pre-COVID arrangements.



Dining room & catering

The retail side of the Dining Room is open for take-away lunches. The kitchen on Level 1 of the MALC building can be used within COVIDsafe protocols. You are encouraged to eat outside where possible.



Masks & distancing

While masks will not be required indoors (except for public transport and front-of-house hospitality), you may want to wear a mask or ask others in large groups to wear masks. All events will need to adhere to the density limits of 1 person per 2sqm indoor area as indicated by the capacity limit signs around campus.
